The Ordinance was then ordered to be published according to law. Notice is hereby given that the said Ordinance will be considered for final passage after a public hearing to be held on the 1st day of March, 2018 at a meeting beginning at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building located on the corner of County Road 519 and Oak Grove Road, Kingwood Township, New Jersey, at which time all interested parties will be heard.

ORDINANCE NO. 19- 02- 2018

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 34 “RECREATION COMMISSION AND PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE,” ARTICLE I “RECREATION COMMISSION,” SECTION 5 “RULES AND REGULATIONS; ADMINISTRATION; ENFORCEMENT; PENALTIES FOR OFFENSES” TO ALLOW FOR THE IMPOSITION OF RESTITUTION AS A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE PARK THAT RESULTS IN THE DAMAGE OF TOWNSHIP PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes to amend Section 34-5 of the Ordinance to allow for the imposition of restitution as a penalty for violations of the Rules and Regulations of the Park results in the damage of Township property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Kingwood, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1:

C. The General Code Enforcement Officer of Kingwood Township and/or the New Jersey State Police and/or such other person(s) designated by the Township Committee shall have the authority to enforce such rules and regulations governing township recreational facilities. Any person violating any of the rules and regulations so enacted shall be liable for a fine of not more than \$100, the imposition of restitution for damage to Township property and/or a term of community service not exceeding 15 days.

Section 2:

If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 3:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are repealed but only to the extent of such inconsistency. All other parts of the Code of the Township of Kingwood not inconsistent herewith are ratified and confirmed.

Section 4:

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication according to law.
