ORDINANCE NO. 19-19-2018

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KINGWOOD, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE DONATION OF LAND LOCATED AT 101 BRYAM LANE, KINGWOOD TOWNSHIP, NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant Program (“FMA”) provides funding to States, Territories, federally-recognized tribes and local communities for projects and planning that reduces or eliminates long-term risk of flood damage to structures insured under the National Flood Insurance Program (“NFIP”) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (“FEMA”) has designated the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management (“OEM”) as the Grantee to receive, administer, and disburse FEMA mitigation funds for local government mitigation projects in areas of New Jersey and to provide technical assistance with the FMA; and

WHEREAS, Warren and Hunterdon County previously entered into a Memorandum of Understanding under which the counties agreed to submit a joint application for the FMA Grant as a regional project and to disburse any funds awarded under the grant between the two counties; and

WHEREAS, Warren County and Hunterdon County submitted a Subgrant Project Application, Scope of Work, Schedule, Summarized Cost Estimate and other documentation setting forth a proposed list of activities for approval by the OEM and FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the proposed action was for the acquisition-demolition of approximately twenty residential structures in Warren and Hunterdon Counties; and

WHEREAS, one of the properties proposed for acquisition and demolition is Block 51, Lot 13 on the Official Tax Map of the Township of Kingwood, more commonly known as 101 Byram Lane, Kingwood, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2005, the Township of Kingwood authorized their participation in the FMA Grant opportunity and agreed to acquire interested Severe Repetitive Loss properties;

WHEREAS, the County of Warren has notified the Township that they are ready to close on this property at which time the property would be transferred to the Township of Kingwood; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires of accepting the property in accordance with the Agreement of Donation between the County of Warren and Kingwood Township.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Kingwood, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, that the Mayor of the Township of Kingwood is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement of Donation between the County of Warren and the Township of Kingwood.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Township of Kingwood is hereby authorized to accepted title to Block 51, Lot for the total sum of \$1.00 subject to the aforementioned Donation Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the Deed and any other documents to effectuate the transfer of this property to the Township of Kingwood.
