

# **TOWNSHIP OF KINGWOOD – CLEAN-UP DAYS 2025**

Kingwood Township will be having clean-up days on the second Saturday of April, May, June, September and the third Saturday in October. **No clean-up days are scheduled for July or August.** Only a limited number of permits will be issued each month. Please call 908-996-4276 ext. 222 for availability of permits.

**HOURS: 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.**  
**LOCATION: Kingwood Township Municipal Garage, 255 Union Road**  
**STARTING: Saturday, April 12, 2025**

- A limited number of permits for each month will be available at the Township Municipal Building located at 599 Oak Grove Road, Frenchtown.
- The Municipal Building offices are open Monday through Friday 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. If a permit needs to be picked up after Municipal Office hours, please email [deputyclerk@kingwoodtownship.com](mailto:deputyclerk@kingwoodtownship.com) to schedule a pick up on a Tuesday evening, 4-6pm.
- Permits will be available starting Tuesday, March 18, 2025, and thereafter the Tuesday following each monthly clean-up day. See the schedule on the following page.
- Residents will be allowed/issued one permit per month.
- Residents must obtain a new permit each month with a TWO-month limit. For more than two visits, please call 908-996-4276 ext. 222 or email [deputyclerk@kingwoodtownship.com](mailto:deputyclerk@kingwoodtownship.com) to request to be placed on an availability list.
- Residents must provide proof of residency (valid driver’s license, current tax bill, voter registration card) and the license plate number of the vehicle to be used.
- The permit must be presented to DPW personnel before the vehicle is allowed to unload.
- Unloading the vehicle is the permit holder’s responsibility, however, the Public Works Department personnel will be available to assist with unloading heavy and bulky items.

## **The following restrictions apply:**

- No Electronics – use Hunterdon County E-Waste program (check county website for dates – next event scheduled for June 14, 2025)
- Appliances containing freon gas will be accepted only if accompanied by certification of removal of freon.

NO DUMP TRUCKS OR TRAILERS ALLOWED.**

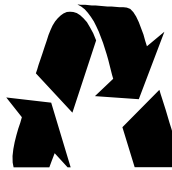
