Richard Tutela from Energy Price Management Group called over the telecom to give a presentation. He introduced himself to the Committee Members and reviewed the Energy Price Management Group Smart Term Program for Kingwood Township. He explained how they avoid the use of the typical 12 – 24 monthly fix price commonly offered in the market by using EPMG's Smart-Term Program, Energy PMG finds the lowest cost term from multiple suppliers and monitors the market to find the best rate for future term extensions.

Richard Tutela reviewed the terms and prices from a handout which was provided to everyone. The Committee Members requested the Township Clerk to find out when the current energy program expires.

Committeewoman, Syrnick, Liaison for Environmental Commission

The Planning Board did not meet this month. The Environmental Commission has received trees and there is another round to be planted. We are in need of volunteers to plant along the Lockatong Creek at the pond by the Department of Public Works building. Well testing kits will be going out this weekend. The Environmental Commission discussed a Census training program, which would be to educate the public since Kingwood only has a 50% return on the Census. They would use funds from the Environmental Commission's account.

Deputy Mayor, Dodds, Liaison for Parks and Recreation/Open Space/Ag Committees

The Pinebrook Farms closed recently. The state closed on the Dixon/Fleming Farm.

The Parks and Recreation would like to spend the funds left over from the prior Parks and Recreation account.

# Mayor, Ciacciarelli, Liaison for Department of Public Works

An addition to the intercom system was installed in the municipal building this week. The Mayor does not anticipate opening the municipal building up to the public until the first of the year due to the rise in cases of COVID-19. Everything seems to be going well. The Construction Department will be able to collect fees through credit cards. The Mayor feels it will be a tight budget year next year, due to all the losses during COVID-19. The township will schedule interviews in October for a Department of Public Works employee to be hired full time to help out with the maintenance of the parks.

## Cameras for Municipal Building

The township's hard drive needs to replace it. The Township Committee discussed different options for purchasing cameras for the municipal building. Township to obtain a proposal for blink cameras.

# Knock Out Opioid Abuse Day October 6, 2020

WHEREAS, New Jersey is in the midst of a life-threatening opioid abuse epidemic; and

WHEREAS, the Partnership for a Drug-Free New Jersey has designated October 6, 2020, as Knock Out Opioid Abuse Day – an initiative with a dual purpose: to raise awareness of the potential for dependency on prescribed pain medicine and its link to heroin use rates in our state, reduce stigma of addiction and shine a light on the need for recovery support, and communicate to physicians information on safer prescribing messages found in the Centers for Disease Control and prevention guidelines for prescribing opioids, which include considering other therapies, setting realistic treatment goals with patients and discussing with patients the positives and negatives of opioids; and

WHEREAS, the State Senate and General Assembly jointly resolved that October 6 shall be permanently designated as Knock Out Opioid Abuse Day in New Jersey in order to raise awareness about the dangers of, and the link between, opioid abuse and heroin addiction and to educate health care providers, community leaders, state lawmakers and members of the public about the opioid abuse epidemic and its effects throughout the State of New Jersey and across the country; and

WHEREAS, <u>HCYC (Hunterdon County Youth Coalition)</u> supports initiatives designed to raise awareness about opioid abuse in New Jersey and take steps to prevent addiction;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that October 6, 2020, be recognized as Knock Out Opioid Abuse Day in Kingwood Township.
