ORDINANCE NO. 20-18-2020 AMENDING CHAPTER 57 "ANIMALS," "SECTION 4 LICENSE FEES" OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KINGWOOD, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY - Public Hearing and Final Adoption

ORDINANCE NO. 20 - 18 - 2020

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 57 "ANIMALS," SECTION 4 "LICENSE FEES,≤OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KINGWOOD, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, AND THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes to change the due date for dog licenses and license renewals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Kingwood, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1:

Section 57-4(B) and (C) shall be amended as follows:

§ 57-4 License fees.

- B. Annual dog licenses shall be obtained during the month of January April of each year and specifically on or prior to January April 31 of each year. Said licenses shall expire on February May 1 one year later.
- C. A person who applies for a license subsequent to February May 10 of any year shall pay a penalty of \$15 per license, in addition to the license fee set forth in § 57-4A above. As a courtesy, written notification shall be sent to all persons who have not obtained their annual dog license by February May 20 of any year indicating that those persons have 45 days from February May 20 to obtain their dog license by payment of the \$15 fee set forth in § 57-4A, as well as the late fee of \$15.

The notification shall further state that, should the dog license not be obtained within 45 days following February May 20 of any year, a summons will be issued requiring an appearance in Municipal Court to address the failure of the individual to obtain his/her annual dog license. Should the matter go to court, and the person who has failed to obtain his/her annual dog license be found guilty of that violation, that person will also be responsible to pay all court costs and fines imposed by the court in connection with the matter.
