Township Committee Minutes

February 15, 2022

A Special Meeting of the Kingwood Township Committee was called to order at 7:00P.M. with Mayor Syrnick presiding.

Also present at the meeting were Deputy Mayor Ciacciarelli, Committee Member Russano, C.F.O. Diane Laudenbach, Attorney Kyle Clauss, Deputy Clerk Michele Tipton-Walters, and Clerk Cynthia Keller. Mayor Syrnick called the meeting to order and following the salute to the flag, read aloud the following:

Roll Call

Mayor Syrnick welcomed everyone at this Special Meeting. This is not a regular township meeting, but just a meeting to exchange information and hear the opinions and comments from the public regarding this type of business.

Mayor Syrnick noted there are no applications submitted at this time and there will be no votes this evening.

In July of 2021 the Township Committee adopted **Ordinance No. 21-17- 2021** An Ordinance Prohibiting the Operation of any Class of Cannabis Businesses within its Geographical Boundaries and Amend Chapter 132 "Zoning," Article I "General Provisions," Section 6 "Prohibited Uses," of the Code of the Township of Kingwood to Add Cannabis Businesses to the list of Prohibited Uses.

Mayor Syrnick mentioned reading a lot of misinformation on Facebook regarding this meeting. She proceeded to introduce all the officials for Kingwood Township for the public.

Presentation from Representatives of Essential Cannabis Company LLC

Mayor Syrnick introduced Robert Montuore, President from Essential Cannabis Company, LLC.

Also present from the Essential Cannabis Company were Karen Baker Kurrilo Esq., and Operations/Development Kevin Barry.

Robert Montuore gave a detailed presentation of the company and business plan. This included Community Commitment, Environmental Responsibility, Social Responsibility, Market Size, Competition, Business Model, Growth Strategy and Proposed Facility Design.
