**ORDINANCE NO. 21 – 12 – 2021**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR  
THE RECONSTRUCTION OF RIDGE ROAD, SECTION II  
BY THE TOWNSHIP OF KINGWOOD,  
IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY,  
APPROPRIATING \$161,000.00 THEREFORE**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Committee of the Township of Kingwood in the County of Hunterdon, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) as follows:

Section 1. The improvement described in Section 2 of this ordinance is hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Township of Kingwood, New Jersey as a general improvement. For the improvement or purpose described in Section 2, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$161,000.00. The funding for the ordinance is a through a receipt of a \$150,000.00 grant from the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation and \$11,000.00 from the Capital Improvement Fund.


